U23 PROGRAM DEVELOPING LOCAL PLAYERS



It is important for us to provide an opportunity for local players to improve as athletes. Creating more teams within the club moves us closer toward our mission of developing local talent while *uniting* our community through soccer.

The U23 teams will allow local players to play in the summer during their college off-season from the end of May through July. This will be a shortened season for those players who return home in the summers and travel will be limited to the suburban areas.





FOOTBALL TERMINOLOGY

PITCH: The field of play, with a length of 115-120 yards, and a width of 70-75 yards

OFFSIDE: When an attacking player is beyond the last non-goalkeeping defender on the pitch, is ahead of the ball, and is participating (or moves to participate) in the play. Offside is judged at the moment the ball is played forward, and the call may be delayed as participation is determined.

PENALTY AREA: An area extending six yards out from each goal post, and 18 yards from the goal line, marked by a white line. When the defense commits a foul inside this area, the offense is awarded a penalty kick,

SPOT KICK: A penalty kick, taken from a spot 12 yards from the goal. One offensive player takes a free shot at goal with only the goalkeeper to defend. Player must make the shot in one, continuous, forward motion

TAKING THE POINTS: Winning the match, which is worth three points in the standings

SHARING THE POINTS: Drawing (or tieing) the match, which awards each team one point in the standings

HOWLER: A horrible mistake, usually made by a goalkeeper or defender, resulting in a goal

BLINDER: A player, usually a goalkeeper, having an incredibly great match performance on the day

GANTRY: The press box area for the media, PA announcer, and broadcast personnel

BOOKING: A caution, so named because the referee records the player's number on a card or notebook

SENDING OFF: An ejection from the match due to serious violations of the rules, or because the player has received a second caution in the match

CROSS: A pass from the wing position on the field into the penalty area for a potential shot on goal

SET PIECE: Plays resulting from the re-start of the game, generally either a direct free kick or a corner kick

OUT OF TOUCH: A ball going out of play by crossing either sideline (touch line)

OVER THE BYELINE: A ball going out of play by crossing the goal line, but not resulting in a goal

OWN GOAL: A goal scored by the defense against itself by accidentally playing into their own goal. A shot that deflects off a defender on its way into the goal is not generally scored as an own goal.

FORMATION: The number of defenders, midfielders, and forwards playing on the pitch, generally known by the number. In a 4-4-2 formation, there are 4 defenders, 4 midfielders, and 2 forwards. In a 4-3-3, there are 4 defenders, 3 midfielders, and 3 forwards.


